*Students will complete the remaining six hours of the humanities requirement, including one course in literature, at universities upon transfer. Students who plan to transfer to the University of Memphis should complete a course in literature rather than music appreciation.

Students must successfully complete placement requirements in music theory, ear training, **musicology and piano **as required by** the university where transfer is planned. Students must successfully complete required university auditions **prior to admission**. Auditions by universities take place in Semester 3 or early in Semester 4. Plan ahead.

***Students who plan to transfer to University of Memphis and major in Music Business should take ECON 2100: Principles of Macroeconomics to fulfill one of these requirements.
