NOTES:

1. Students who plan to transfer to the UoM must complete at least one fine arts under the Humanities & Fine Arts general education requirement. Students planning to transfer to MTSU can take an approved Anthropology course in either the Humanities & Fine Arts or in an Area of Emphasis.
2. Students who plan to transfer to UTK will be required to complete - HIST 2210: Early Western Civilization and HIST 2220: Modern Western Civilization.
3. Students who plan to transfer to UTM or UTK are encouraged to take the BIOL1110/1120 sequence.
4. Students who plan to transfer to UTK will be required to complete an additional Mathematics course from the following: MATH 1010, 1530, 1630, 1830 or 1910.
5. TTP Students planning to transfer to the UoM will need to complete six hours of a 2000 level or higher foreign language to earn the Bachelor of Arts degree. Students who plan to transfer to UTK will be required to demonstrate intermediate-level competency in Foreign Language before graduating from UTK. Students may demonstrate intermediate-level competence after transferring to UTK.
