- <sup>1.</sup> Students who plan to transfer to the UoM must complete at least one fine arts under the Humanities & Fine Arts general education requirement.
- <sup>2.</sup> Students planning to transfer to MTSU can take an approved Anthropology course in either the Humanities & Fine Arts or in an Area of Emphasis.
- 3. Students who plan to transfer to UTK must complete a natural science sequence.
- 4. Consult the academic catalog or an advisor at your transferring institution to determine if this History elective course may count towards your intended transfer major or as a general elective.
- 5. Students planning to transfer to TTU can choose from any two of the four courses listed to complete this area of emphasis requirement.
- <sup>6.</sup> Students who plan to transfer to UTK or UTC will be required to demonstrate intermediate level competency in Foreign Language before graduating either institution. Students may demonstrate intermediate-level competence after transferring. Students may take these additional foreign language courses to fulfill the Elective category.
- <sup>7.</sup> A total of 4 credit hours in unspecified, transferable electives is needed to complete the degree requirements.
