## NOTES:

1. Students who plan to transfer to the UoM must complete at least one fine arts under the Humanities \& Fine Arts general education requirement.
2. Students planning to transfer to MTSU can take an approved Anthropology course in either the Humanities \& Fine Arts or in an Area of Emphasis.
3. Students who plan to transfer to UTK must complete a natural science sequence.
4. Consult the academic catalog or an advisor at your transferring institution to determine if this History elective course may count towards your intended transfer major or as a general elective.
5. Students planning to transfer to TTU can choose from any two of the four courses listed to complete this area of emphasis requirement.
6. Students who plan to transfer to UTK or UTC will be required to demonstrate intermediate level competency in Foreign Language before graduating either institution. Students may demonstrate intermediate-level competence after transferring. Students may take these additional foreign language courses to fulfill the Elective category.
7. A total of 4 credit hours in unspecified, transferable electives is needed to complete the degree requirements.
