- Students who plan to transfer to the UoM must complete at least one fine arts s the Humanities & Fine Arts class general education requirement. Students planning to transfer to MTSU can take an approved Anthropology course in either the Humanities & Fine Arts or in an Area of Emphasis.
- ^{2.} Students planning to transfer to UTK, should complete HIST 2010 and HIST 2320.
- 3. Students planning to transfer to UTK should complete an 8-hour natural science lab sequence.
- Students planning to attend UTK should take than 1130: College Algebra or higher.
- 5. Check with your advisor for recommended courses when selecting guided electives.
- Students planning to transfer to the UoM will need to complete six hours of a 2000 level or higher foreign language to earn the Bachelor of Arts degree. Students who plan to transfer to UTK will be required to demonstrate intermediate-level competency in Foreign Language before graduating from UTK. Students may demonstrate intermediate level competence after transferring to UTK.
