- 1. Students who plan to transfer to ETSU are encouraged to take Speech 2320 if pursuing the BS in Psychology (applicable to AA/AS pathways).
- ^{2.} Students who plan to transfer to the UoM must complete at least one fine arts class under the Humanities & Fine Arts general education requirement.
- 3. Students intending to transfer to UTC or APSU should complete social/behavioral science courses from two separate disciplines (e.g., SOC 1010; CRMJ 1010, etc.); It is recommended that students take PSYC 1030 at the four-year and choose another approved social/behavioral gen ed course.
- 4. Students intending to transfer to UTK should complete a Western or World History sequence.
- 5. Students who plan to transfer to ETSU must complete a natural science sequence.
- Students should seek the guidance of four-year advisors before choosing an area of emphasis Psychology requirement.

 Depending on the four-year institution you select, these courses may be applied to the major or to elective requirements.
- ^{7.} Students planning to transfer to the UoM or UTK will need to complete six hours of a 2000 level or higher foreign language to earn the Bachelor of Arts degree.
