## NOTES:

- <sup>1.</sup> Students who plan to transfer to the UoM must complete at least one fine arts under the Humanities & Fine Arts general education requirement. Students are encouraged to take an approved Ethics course, if applicable.
- <sup>2.</sup> Students who intend to transfer to UoM should take LIT 2201 or LIT 2202 to fulfill this requirement. TSU also recommends a LIT sequence.
- <sup>3.</sup> ETSU requires a BIOL sequence: 1010: Intro to Biology and1020 Diversity of Life or 1110/1120 General Biology I & II. TSU recommends BIOL 1010 c APSU accepts Math 1510 or Math 1530.
- <sup>4.</sup> Students who intend to transfer to ETSU are required to take a Social Work elective. If not offered at a student's school, such a course can be completed via the TN eCampus.
- <sup>5.</sup> Students interested in transferring to TSU should take an Economics course. UM and UTC require an Anthropology course.
- <sup>6.</sup> Students who intend to transfer to UTM should take BIOL 2010: Human Anatomy and Physiology I as an unspecified elective. Students who intend to transfer to APSU should take BIOL 2010 (Human Anatomy and Physiology) as one of their natural science electives.
- <sup>7.</sup> For students planning on transferring to UTK you will need 1-year intermediate level sequence in a single foreign language. A total of 7 credit hours are unspecified, transferable electives are needed to complete the degree requirements.
