- <sup>1.</sup> Students who plan to transfer to the UoM must complete at least one fine arts under the Humanities & Fine Arts general education requirement. Students are encouraged to take an approved Ethics course, if applicable.
- <sup>2.</sup> Students who intend to transfer to UoM should take LIT 2201 or LIT 2202 to fulfill this requirement. TSU also recommends a LIT sequence.
- <sup>3.</sup> ETSU requires a BIOL sequence: 1010: Intro to Biology and/1020 Diversity of Life or 1110/1120 General Biology I & II. TSU recommends any Biology sequence.
- <sup>4.</sup> APSU accepts Math 1510 or Math 1530.
- <sup>5.</sup> Students interested in attending ETSU are required to take a Social Work elective. If not offered at a student's school, such a course can be completed via the TN eCampus.
- <sup>6.</sup> Students interested in attending TSU are required to take an Economics. Students interested in attending UoM or UTC are required to take an Anthropology.
- <sup>7.</sup> Students who intend to transfer to UTM should take BIOL 2010: Human Anatomy and Physiology I as an unspecified elective. Students who intend to transfer to APSU should take BIOL 2010 (Human Anatomy and Physiology) as one of their natural science electives.
